### Can you describe what a typical working week looks like for you?

“ A typical week for me would involve splitting my time between my business-as-usual, projects and my apprenticeship. I allocate 20% of my week towards my apprenticeship. This involves an afternoon spent completing assignments, revision, workshops or webinars, and the rest is spent applying my learning within my job role. For example, applying a new skill during project development. ”

“ In addition to the qualification I will gain, I feel the development of my skills has, and will, continue to support me within my role. The business has been very supportive and has provided me with the time to complete my assignments, as well as giving me the chance to lead on projects, where I have utilised my new skills and learning. ”

“ For anyone wanting to develop their skills within their current role, I would recommend looking into an apprenticeship. There are various qualifications available under the apprenticeship scheme, so I believe there is something for everyone. ”
